

Frequently Asked Questions

- Our worship service times are changing because we are transitioning to two (2) worship services.
 - Start date: July 4, 2021
 - New Service times: 8:00 am and 10:45 am
- Will everyone be allowed to attend in-person services?
 - Yes, we may maintain 6-feet social distancing protocol for all attendees.
- When I attend worship services will I have to comply with any special protocol such as wearing a mask and or having my temperature taken?
 - Yes, you will have to comply with answering a Covid-19 questionnaire, wear a mask throughout the service, and submit to a temperature check before or upon entering the sanctuary.
 - Please allow ample time to complete the screening process before entering the sanctuary, which should be no longer than 5 minutes.
 - If for whatever reason, medical or otherwise, you cannot wear a mask throughout the length of service, we ask that you please attend virtual worship service. Once the current restrictions are lifted, you are welcomed to return to in-person worship.
 - We will continue to monitor our protocols and adjust them as needed.
- What if my temperature is outside of normal range and elevated due to the heat or exercise? Will I still be able to enter the sanctuary?
 - Hot weather and or exercise may have a minimal, temporary affect of your internal temperature. Therefore, if your initial temperature check reading is at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, which is the threshold recommended by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), we will ask you to wait in a designated area and a Medical Advocacy volunteer will recheck your temperature after one minute. If your temperature remains equal to or above 100.4 degrees, we will respectfully ask you leave and join us virtually.
- Will I be able to sit in my favorite seat?
 - We have lifted mandatory seating by our Ushers so you may now choose your own seat. However, we will still leave every other row empty until further notice.
- Will the Praise team, choir and music ministry be in attendance?
 - Yes, we plan to have dynamic music and singing.
- If we are still following strict PPE and social distancing protocol, will I have to get up to pass the offering basket to my neighbor on my row?

- No. We will not pass baskets anymore for offering. We will have baskets or receptacles set up at the exits so that you can drop your offering envelopes on your way out.
 - We will also encourage you to continue giving via PushPay, text (PRBC to 833-810-6600), or mail.
- Will we still have baptismal service(s) on second Sunday?
 - Baptisms have been suspended for now. We hope to resume them in the near future.
- What should I do if I (or family members with whom I attend church) am not feeling well? Should I still attend church on Sunday?
 - No, we invite you to please join us at one of our virtual worship services.
- What improvements has the church made to help keep everyone safe in the sanctuary?
 - We have installed Aerus Air-scrubber technology to our HVAC system to purify the air in the sanctuary and other buildings on campus. Though there is nothing that can completely eliminate Covid-19 or other airborne virus from the air, the Aerus technology is one of the most effective available.
- Will the church be cleaned and sanitized between services?
 - Yes, we will use electrostatic disinfectant sprayers to sanitize doors, pews, restrooms, and other contact surfaces to help slow the potential spread of Covid-19 and other potential harmful viruses and bacteria.
- Will I have to have been Covid-19 vaccinated to attend in-person worship services and show proof of vaccination?
 - No, you do not have to be vaccinated to attend worship services. If you have been, you will do not have to show proof of vaccination to attend services.
