



PILGRIM REST BAPTIST CHURCH FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Instructions:

- Applicants must be members of Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church.
- Applicants must have graduated from high school by May 2018 and have been accepted in a Four-year University, two-year College, or certificated program for the Fall 2018 semester.
- Applications received after the due date noted above will not be considered.
- **Please respond to all questions and include a copy of your end of year report card and/or transcript.**
- Two types of scholarships will be awarded:
 1. **FULL Tuition Scholarship Award** – This award will be granted to two students. This award will be distributed to the recipients each semester for four (4) years contingent upon the recipient maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0. The amount of this scholarship is equivalent to tuition rates charged at public universities in the state of Arizona. However, the award may be applied toward tuition at any accredited four-year college or university. (Note: undergraduate only)
 2. **One-Time Scholarship Award** - Numerous students will receive one-time scholarships. These one-time scholarships will vary in amounts and may be used at any formal educational institution.
- Applications must be submitted to the church office at 1401 E. Jefferson Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85034 (Mon.-Fri. 9AM – 5PM) in person; by US mail or any mail carrier; by fax - 602-258-0840 (if faxing it is your responsibility to follow up to confirm that your fax was received); or by email as an attachment to education@pilgrimrestphx.org.
- Another component of the application process is a personal interview. If you are selected for a personal interview, the scholarship committee will contact you to set up time and date of your interview.
