FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

Instructions:

- Applicants must be members of Pilgrim Rest Baptist Church.
- Applicants must have **graduated from high school by May 2026** and have been accepted as a Freshman in a Four-year University, two-year College, or certificated program for the **Fall 2026 semester**.
- Applications received after the due date noted above will **NOT** be considered.
- **Please respond to all questions and include a copy of your final high school transcript.**
- Please submit a copy of your official letter of admission for the Fall 2026 semester.
- Two types of scholarships will be awarded:
 1. **FULL Tuition Scholarship Award** – The amount of this scholarship is equivalent to tuition rates charged at public universities in the state of Arizona. Students may use this scholarship at any in-state or out-of-state accredited four-year university or college. This award will be distributed to the recipient(s) each semester for four (4) years contingent upon the recipient(s) maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0.
 2. **One-Time Scholarship Award** - Numerous students will receive one-time scholarships. These one-time scholarships will vary in amounts and may be used at any formal educational institution.
- Applications must be submitted by one of the following mediums. Please note the time deadline will vary depending on the medium chosen. If you **email, please send to education@pilgrimrestphx.org by 11:00pm**. If you deliver **in person to the church office at 1401 E. Jefferson Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85034, please bring on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 9AM and 4:30PM**. If you are **mailing to the church office, send to 1401 E. Jefferson Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85034**. If submitting by US mail or any other mail carrier, please mail your application early enough to reach our office by the deadline (**4:30pm, June 6th 2026**). **PLEASE DO NOT FAX APPLICATIONS TO THE CHURCH OFFICE.**
- Another component of the application process is a personal interview. If you are selected for an interview, the scholarship committee will contact you to set up date and time of your interview.
